#### A Sense of Touch

In this sensory workshop, participants will first play a game in which they reach into a box, feel various objects and try to identify what the objects are using only their sense of touch. Afterwards, they will create a craft journal, where they will paste various materials and objects they can touch in order to document and learn about different types of textures and the way they feel.

#### **Music and Art**

Participants will first be introduced to a variety of musical instruments to discover the sounds and music they are able to produce. Then they will make upcycled instruments from recyclable and everyday products.

#### **How to Draw Manga 1 (with FOCAL POINT)**

Designed for two different age groups, these two workshops focus on manga comics and graphic novels, which are at the heart of Japanese pop and entertainment culture. Informed by the contemporary art in the FOCAL POINT art book fair and the *SHARJAPAN2* exhibition, both workshops invite participants to learn the art of Japanese manga and techniques for creating comic strips.

# **Observing the Other**

Education Workshop for People with Disabilities Thursday, 21 November 2019 10:00 am–12:00 pm Art for All Center, Al Mureijah Ages 3–6

Languages: Arabic and English

In this workshop, participants will observe and imitate various facial gestures and/or body movements during play, such as raising both arms above their heads and then dropping one arm down and seeing if other participants can imitate. They will also learn how to read social cues and facial expressions as well as tone of voice and body language. Finally, they will create faces on paper plates that depict the different facial expressions they have learnt.
