

## Spring 2019 Education Programme for People with Disabilities 19 March –2 May 2019

The Spring 2019 Education Programme for People with Disabilities, scheduled from 19 March to 2 May, has been inspired and informed by the work of Sharjah Biennial 14 artists. It includes a wide range of educational offerings for individuals with physical, learning and developmental difficulties. The workshops are designed to help people with disabilities aged 7 and above to discover new ways of self-expression through art. All workshops are facilitated by experienced professionals, and sessions are conducted in English and Arabic, according to the needs of the participants.

Workshops organised by the Education Programme for People with Disabilities are free and open to the public. Materials and equipment for the sessions will be provided by the foundation, and workshops will take place either in Al Mureijah or Arts Square in the city of Sharjah, unless otherwise noted.

Sharjah Art Foundation is committed to making its programmes as inclusive and accessible as possible. Disability access symbols are included in all Education and Community Programme descriptions to indicate the accessibility of individual sessions.

## Spring 2019 Workshops and Excursions

### **Workshop: Make, Explore and Paint Rainbows**

In parallel with the art work of Aline Baiane (*Alliance for a Sunny World*), participants will explore how various mediums could create rainbow reflections and then draw and colour their own version of a rainbow.

### **Workshop: Create Your Own Stool Chair**

### **Workshop: Modern Islamic Art Workshop**

Anwar Jalal Shemza reinvents Islamic art using modern motifs and Western aesthetics. In this workshop, participants will first visit Shemza's Islamic art exhibition for inspiration. Then they will be equipped with several mediums and tools so they can recreate their own rendition of the artist's works using circle and square motifs as well as a Spirograph to create geometrical shapes prevalent in Islamic art.

When artist Lee Mingwei's grandmother passed away, he still had many things to say to her but it was too late. For the next year and a half, he wrote many letters to her and shared his thoughts and feelings with her. The artist's *Letter Writing Project* is a platform where visitors can write the letters they had always meant to write but have never taken the time to do so. In a similar fashion, participants in this workshop will learn the basics of letter writing, create their own postcards and then head to the nearby post office to mail them to loved ones.
