do it بالعربي Photo Walk

Sharjah Art Foundation is organising a photo walk to activate do it עובים instructions written by participating artists Hazem Harb and Mohammed Kazem. For the first part of the tour, participants will follow Hazem Harb's instructions by observing the architecture of the area. During their research they will identify important yet neglected buildings which they will document. Participants will then redraw the buildings of their choice. On the second part of the tour, participants will follow instructions by the artist Mohammed Kazem. The instructions require participants to look for buildings in the Arts Area and mark them using GPS coordinates, the GPS coordinates will be converted to vinyl and will be used as the medium for an artwork.
