### WORKSHOPS

#### Sight Tours

Children listen to specially trained expert give extensive visual descriptions of artwork and participate in discussions about artists, exhibition and artwork.



#### Touch Tours

Examine through touch a wide range of objects from SAF's ongoing exhibition programme.



#### Drawing Workshop

Participants learn the foundations of drawing using SAF's exhibitions as a source of inspiration.



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### Collage a Landscape

This workshop focuses on the collage technique. Using various materials, participants make their own individual landscapes.



### Painting Workshop

Children learn the fundamentals of painting using acrylic and watercolour on canvas, paper and wood.



### Play with Clay

This workshop offers a simple introduction to basic pottery techniques. Participants learn to mold clay into different objects and shapes then paint using their favourite colours.



### Masquerade

Children design and make their own masks from papier-mâché. A stencil cutout will be provided for children to mold, shape and decorate.



### Look and Listen

In this drawing workshop, children listen to various pieces of music and put pastel to paper, exploring music, sound and movement.



### Creative Movement Workshop

A spontaneous and playful class, participants learn to explore and express different parts of their personality through body movements and improvisations.
