WORKSHOPS

How We Respond to Art



Children will create a tool to take with them on tours of the SB12 exhibitions to help them express their emotions towards art. This tool is a simple illustrated face that can be easily customised to show their feelings towards the artworks they are viewing.

Sight Tours



Children listen to detailed descriptions of artwork and participate in open discussions about artists and the exhibition. They will also use their other senses to help them engage and interact with the work presented.

Sculpting with Found Objects



With the use of found objects, participants are encouraged to create sculptures related to the present and the possible. Children will be asked to work individually or in groups depending on their disability level. Throughout the biennial participants will be offered the opportunity to add to the series of sculptures, contributing to the development of this ongoing artwork.

Printmaking



In this introductory course to printmaking, children will learn the various methods of creating prints, from additive to reductive, and applying them in their own style to make interesting works of art.

Bookmaking



This workshop will introduce participants to the fundamentals of bookbinding and its various forms in order to create and design their own book. Basic instructions in a step-by-step form will be given to participants to ensure the quality of their stitching, binding and bookmaking.

XYZ



Children play games using their sense of smell, touch and hearing on a specially designed court by SB12 participating artist Eduardo Navarro.

Across the Chalk Line Cricket Oval



Children will have the chance to improve their cricket pitching skill in the game of cricket in a secure cricket oval created by SB12 participating artist Gary Simmons.

Textures and More



Participants will play with various elements on flat surfaces of colourful dough to explore the different methods of creating texture. By the end of this workshop, children will be creating colourful and tactile tiles.

Painting on Acrylic Sheets



Children will paint on acrylic sheets and give life to their artworks by adding found objects to their work. In this workshop they will learn the importance of layering and its usage in making art.

Play and Perform



Working together in groups, children will learn how to use body expressions and facial expressions to present a play in a theatrical manner.

Playing with Layers



Using flat surfaces, participants cut out shapes, stack and layer them one upon the other to create a high relief artwork.

Painting with Foam Balls



Children will create artworks by using foam balls and paint. Participants will paint the balls then allow them to roll on a piece of paper to create their own artwork.

Travel across the Emirate of Sharjah to explore different artworks that are a part of Sharjah Biennial 12. Children and their families are welcome.
