Drawing for All

In this workshop participant of all abilities will be able to explore different methods of drawing.

Quilting with Clay

Participants will experience a new concept of quilting, using clay to create a textured tile.



Sgraffito

This workshop offers a unique way of learning positive and negative space by making sgraffito paper to scratch on, and create a unique artwork.

Illuminated Jars

Participants will create their own radiant and glowing jars in a workshop inspired by *the Light Show*.

Illuminated Figure

This workshop will introduce the making of customised three-dimensional objects through the use of cardboard. With the use of glow in the dark paints, participants will be able to illuminate the figures.



Art Expression

Participants will create a tool to take with them on tours of the exhibitions to help them express their emotions towards art. This tool will be an illustrated face that can be customised continuously to show their feelings towards the artworks they are viewing.

WORKSHOPS FOR YOUNGER PARTICIPANTS AGES 3-6



Ebru

Participants will learn about Ebru; the art of painting on water and transferring it onto paper, through the use of everyday items.

Blotto Painting

Participants will be introduced to blotto painting; a technique in which an abstract painting is made through folding a painted paper. The focus of this workshop is abstract painting and the basics of colour mixing.
