Along with their families, those aged 6 to 15 can connect with and learn first-hand from SB15 artists, locally based artists, art practitioners and community members.

Offered in English and/or Arabic, the April sessions take place in Sharjah—at the Collections Building and Bait Obaid Al Shamsi in Arts Square and the Sharjah Maritime Museum in Al Khan.

The Sharjah Biennial 15 Mural Project has been inspired by SB15 artist Pipo Nguyen-Duy's work (My) East of Eden (2011–2013), which reflects on the artist's childhood in Vietnam.
