

Sharjah Biennial 15: Thinking Historically in the Present **Schools Programme** 17 February-11 June 2023

From 17 February to 11 June 2023, students aged 6 to 18 can enjoy tours and workshops inspired by the work of the international artists and collectives participating in Sharjah Biennial 15: Thinking Historically in the Present. School groups can take a tour as a stand-alone activity, or they can participate in both a tour and a workshop. A tour can provide important context for the activities in a workshop.

Interested schools and community centres can select the tours and/or workshops as well as dates and times that are most appropriate for them. Workshops, with or without a tour, usually take two hours. Tours alone are generally 30 minutes. Sessions are conducted in Arabic and /or English, depending on the needs of the participants.

All Schools Programme tours and workshops, except for visits to Rain Room (where the admission charge is discounted for students), are free and open to all. Materials are provided by Sharjah Art Foundation.

WORKSHOP

Paper Weaving

Ages: 10+

Date: To be decided with schools and community centres Duration: Two hours Location: <u>Collections Building, Arts Square, Sharjah</u> Languages: English and Arabic



Learn how to weave, and create different patterns using colourful paper. Take inspiration from the work of SB15 artist Nelly Sethna, whose figurative tapestries entwine natural designs with geometric and ritual diagrams.

Create Shadow Art

Ages: 6+

Date: To be decided with schools and community centres Duration: Two hours Location: <u>Collections Building, Arts Square, Sharjah</u> Languages: English and Arabic



Inspired by SB15 artist Aziza Shadenova's installation featuring silhouettes of hands, vases and other objects, make your own colourful artworks with projected shadows of different kinds of toys (e.g. cars, dolls and animals). First, you will outline the shadow of a toy on cardboard and cut out the shape. Then you can decorate your shadow shape with markers and coloured paper, which you will insert into spaces you have cut out of the cardboard. Finally, you can project light on your shadow artwork to produce a new shadow that looks like stained glass.
