Engraving and Printing (Beginner) Ages 17+

Develop a solid understanding of the fundamentals of engraving, printing, graphic design and twodimensional surface analysis through symbols, lines and visual vocabulary. Learn to design various surfaces according to aesthetic values, create gradations from white to black, and build your skill in different drawing and painting techniques, including shading, hatching and pointillism. Engraving and Printing (Intermediate) Ages 17+

Master various techniques for engraving and printing, from monoprint to collagraph, and gain an understanding of the differences between single and duplicate prints and multicoloured and one-colour prints. You will also learn how to print stamps, manually produce paper and make paper look like marble.

Engraving and Printing (Advanced)

Explore a range of printing methods, from linoleum block printing to flatbed silk screen printing and intaglio printing on metal. Experiment with combining the methods for different approaches to composition and various thematic contexts.

Drawing and Painting (Beginner) Ages 17+

Delve into the main elements of an artwork, starting from line, shape, composition, shadow and light, passing through tactile values and ending with colour theories. Learn about the colour wheel, complementary colours, hot and cold colours, and primary, secondary and tertiary colours. You will also apply some principles and elements of perspective to still life paintings.

Painting and Drawing (Intermediate)

Ages 17+

The second stage in the study of painting and drawing, this course is designed to improve participants' skills in drawing with pencil and charcoal and enhance their technique in painting with watercolours and oil or acrylic paint. Participants will practise with a variety of subjects for still life paintings and produce drawings for gypsum sculptures. They will also be introduced to some basic principles for drawing the human face and learn the monochrome technique.

Ceramics (Beginner)

Ages 17+

Ceramics are a link between the fine arts and applied arts. In this course, participants will learn different ways to produce ceramics, whether with clay ropes, clay slabs or a combination of both. Participants will also use clay in some works of glass painting, and they will be trained in various methods of applying colour and casting ceramics.
